Scholarship Submittal Requirements

Heartland Power Cooperative

Requirements:

1. **Complete:** Complete this form by typing or printing.
2. **Transcript:** Enclose your current high school transcript.
3. **Exam:** Enclose a copy of your college entrance examination (ACT and/or SAT) scores if you have taken the test.
4. **Essay:** Enclose a short essay, written by you, with emphasis on your citizenship, leadership and character. This requires what you have been involved with in high school, community and school activities. Please include a little information regarding your family, employment history and what your future career goals are and whether they include locating back to this area.
5. **Letters:** Enclose *two* letters of reference, one from the local high school and one from another source.
6. **Submit:** Mail your application and all supporting documentation before February 1st to:

The requirements to be eligible for the HPC scholarship are to be a U.S. citizen and you must be planning to enroll in a full-time accredited, two-year or four-year college or vocational/technical school in Iowa or Minnesota.

The scholarship is for one year, with the scholarship award being paid directly to the school being attended by the recipient (one-half being paid each semester). We would like the student to maintain a 2.0 grade point average; however, exceptions will be considered if the student is sincere and is working hard to pursue further education. Heartland further reserves the right to revoke a scholarship award in the event a recipient's conduct is indicative of values not supported by Heartland Power Cooperative, and that would likely jeopardize a student's ability to succeed in post-secondary education (such as but not limited to criminal activity).

All scholarship entries are confidential and will only be viewed by the Cooperative's College Selection committee. Applications will not be considered unless the required information is complete.
